

NON-STANDARD SAMPLE FEE SCHEDULE

The non-standard samples listed below are examples of samples which can be tested in lieu of cheek swab samples. These samples may be found in a hospital or personal residence. They may be historical samples or they can be samples which are collected from a living individual.

Non-standard samples are treated by our laboratory “forensically” in that they require individual treatment and specialized laboratory procedures in order to maximize the probability of successfully extracting the DNA. While our laboratory makes every effort to obtain DNA from non-standard samples, we cannot guarantee that we will be successful in every case. Also depending on the circumstances under which the sample was collected, stored and shipped, a non-standard sample may or may not qualify as a proper “Chain of Custody” sample.
